Player's Notice

PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Players are to be on time and dressed prior to their games. Please, no dressing on the field, use the change rooms. We have had complaints regarding players changing in the Dome, plus it causes considerable clutter.
Games start a maximum of 5 minutes past the hour, ready or not. There is a two-minute break between halves. Three minutes are allowed to exit the field after the game.
Players are reminded that shin pads and socks are mandatory. Any player without them cannot play in the game.
Braces and casts must be covered with foam or other soft material to the satisfaction of the game official prior the start of the game.
- Please refrain from using foul language. Referees are instructed to call penalties for offensive language.
- Please no spitting or gum on the field. Gum is particularly difficult to remove from our artificial turf.
- Our staff are considered soccer officials. Insulting the staff may result in a red card and a suspension.
- Players that have been issued a red card must leave the building and may not sit in the stands or on the bench. If necessary, referees have been instructed to stop the game to ensure offending player(s) comply.
- Red cards will be issued for fighting. Several players have been permanently expelled from the Dome for fighting. NO SECOND CHANCES. Govern yourselves accordingly.
- Spectators are a team's responsibility. If team supporters are abusing the officials, staff, opposing players or other spectators, the official will issue a warning. If the abuse continues the official may stop the game, causing the offending spectator's team to forfeit the game.
- Once players have registered and paid, their names will be on the game sheets. All discrepancies must be dealt with at the front desk prior to the player being permitted to play in the game. It is the captain/contact/coaches responsibility to ensure all players playing are on the game sheet. A team will forfeit their game if a player plays who is not on the game sheet. NO EXCEPTIONS.

CANCELLATIONS

- Please call your coach if you can't make a game. Coaches please make arrangements for another parent or assistant to take over your coaching duties if you can't make it to a game.
- Snow days or other cancellations will be posted on our web site www.barriesportsdome.com and broadcast on Rock 95, B101 and Chay 93.1. We do not cancel games for snow unless there are road closures that affect player's ability to get to the Dome. In the event of a cancellation Coaches will be called immediately to notify their players.

SCHEDULING / STATS

- Schedules are posted on the web site. We try to minimize schedule changes. Any schedule changes will be posted in the Dome, given to coaches and posted on the web site.
- Standings and scoring stats, plus playoff arrangements are posted on the soccer bulletin board adjacent to the Dome washrooms as well as division stats on the web site.

NEXT SCHEDULE REGISTRATION

- We expect each of our schedules to be absolutely full with waiting lists for each division. Please pay attention to our notices re: registration dates. It is each team/player's responsibility to register on time. You are not considered registered until you fee is fully paid, and we have received a signed registration form for each player. NO EXCEPTIONS
- Team contacts; please let us know your intentions ASAP. A reminder that if you want to have control of your team, you must enter as a team. At that point the team can determine the number of players that they have, otherwise we will fill the teams with players as they register. All team fees and documents must be handed in together at the time of registration. NO EXCEPTIONS.

PARENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- Children under ten are not to be left unattended during your games. Please do not let your children play behind the netting, as there are electrical wires there. Children are not allowed to play in the sand trap or on the short field were there may be golfers. Children must be supervised at all times. The Barrie Sports Dome is not responsible for any injuries occurring due to children being left unattended.

OSA REGISTRATION / INSURANCE

- Barrie Sports Dome Indoor Soccer Club is not affiliated with the Huronia District Soccer Association and the Ontario Soccer Association.
- If parents or players are concerned about insurance please consult with your own insurance agent or check into school insurance coverage.

TEAM CAPTAINS

- All teams are required to select a captain for their teams. The captain is the spokes person for the team.
- All communications between teams and referees are to be voiced by the captain only.

EQUAL PLAYING TIME

- Teams that are made up of individuals formed by the Barrie Sports Dome Indoor Soccer Club are all paying equal amounts to play and therefore entitled to equal playing time.

NO INTOXICATED PLAYERS

- Players are not permitted to play in games while intoxicated.
- At the referee's and Dome staff's discretion players will be requested to leave if it is determined that they have been drinking.

REFEREE'S RESPECT

- Respect the referees.
- The decisions of the referee regarding facts connected with play are final.
- The referee may only change a decision on realizing that it is incorrect or, at his/her discretion, on the advice of an assistant referee, provided the he has not restarted play.
- Verbal or physical abuse of referees will absolutely not be tolerated. ZERO TOLERANCE. The fact that you disagree with an official's call does not give you the right to verbally abuse him/her. Harsh suspensions may be the penalty for such abuse.
- If you have a question about a particular call, please write it out on the facts sheets at the front counter and our official will respond.
